How to do Ice Art

When doing Ice Art...

Always have parental supervision.

We recommend this for KS2 but if you believe your KS1 child can do it definitely help them while doing the ice art.

Hope you enjoy doing ice art, and remember, always stay safe!

Equipment:

- Container – this will shape your ice.
- Clingfilm – this will line your container so you can get your ice out easily.
- Ribbon (optional) – if you want it to be hung up.
- Water – to make the ice.
- Food colouring (optional) – if you want it to be colourful.
- Decorations – e.g. fruit, leaves, sticks or anything else you'd like to put into your ice.

Instructions:

1. Line your container with cling film.
2. Fill container with water. **Note: if you want to do hanging art don't make the water too deep.**
3. Add your decorations to the water.

Instructions continued:

4. Add a loop of ribbon, and hang it over the edge of the container. **If doing hanging art.**

5. Add food colouring e.g. 3-4 drops.

6. Make sure you have enough space in your freezer if it is not cold enough to leave out side over night to freeze. Freeze the ice.

Instructions continued:

7. After the ice has frozen, peel the cling film off the container, and lift out.
8. Peel cling film off the ice.
9. Hang it outside.
