

Well Dressing Festival in West Hallam

You are invited to join a **Garden Party at the Moravian Church, The Settlement, Ockbrook:** Saturday 8th July, starting at 2.15pm.

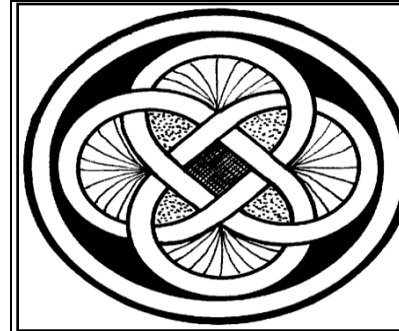
