Mothers' Union Annual Service: 2pm, 13th March at UCAS, Stanley Common led by Rev Alan Fitch.

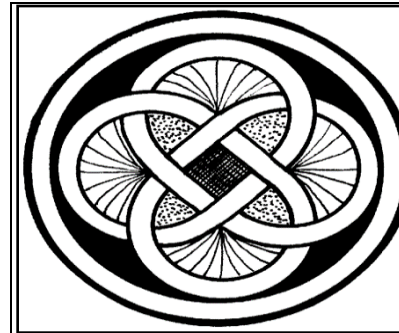
