

Reception Spring term 1 Home learning:

Reading at least 4 times a week is required to be completed each week. These will be checked once a week and completion/incompletion recorded.

Our topic is Why would an elephant not make a good pet?

We will be comparing the UK and India (home and away) as part of our Understanding the World learning. Your tasks over the next 6 weeks. These tasks will be due in on the 12th February so we can celebrate all of the children's hard work in the classroom as a wonderful display. For each piece of home learning completed the children will get 5 dojos.

- Make India in a jar (see attached suggestion sheet for seaside in a jar). We will love to see each child's individual interpretation of the Indian landscape.
- Create a picture of a native animal to the UK using mix media (leaves, sticks, paint, chalk, pastels, wax crayon etc...)
- Phase 2 and 3 tricky words please practise these both reading and writing independently (see copy of the tricky words).
- Safe and unsafe activity sheet – complete the task deciding which activity is safe or not.
- Complete when I'm sad I can poster- children to draw and copy the spelling of names for each one.
- Complete the phase 2 writing – Use the picture to write a full simple sentence such as, The bus is red. These pictures represent only phase 2 sounds and tricky words to create the simple sentence. Please refer to the sound mats provided previously.
