A reminder as we seek to enjoy the lovely sunny weather that the Summer term will (hopefully) bring – please can you ensure your child has a summer hat as well as a water bottle in school. Water bottles can be purchased in the school office for £2.00 and we also have school caps on sale for £2.00.

We do now have sun cream in the playground dispenser and we would like to thank FOSS for supplying this for us. All children are encouraged to apply this at break/lunch time. If your child is allergic to certain sun creams, then please ensure you send in their own sun cream and that this is labelled clearly with their name.

Please can we also ask that children attend school wearing appropriate footwear that meets our uniform standards and is also safe and suitable for the school environment.

Changes to Breakfast Club & After School Club

From Tuesday 5th June, our breakfast club will open at the earlier time of 7.45am. We hope this will make a difference to our working parents with their journey to work.

Also from Tuesday 5^{th} June there will be a small increase in our charges for both the Breakfast and After School Club. Breakfast Club will cost £4 per child per session. The cost of After School Club per child per session will be £4 for 1 hour (until 4.15pm), £8 for 2 hours (until 5.15pm) and £12 for 2^{3} 4 hours (until 6pm).

Also, just a reminder that on the last day of the school year our After School Club will close at 4.15pm. All children must be collected from school by this time.

Childcare Vouchers

If you are a working parent, you could take advantage of the savings that can be made when paying for Breakfast and After School Club by using childcare vouchers. Parents need to act now though as the Childcare Voucher Scheme is closing to new entrants in October and you must have received your first voucher before the cutoff date of 3 October if you want to benefit from these in the future.
