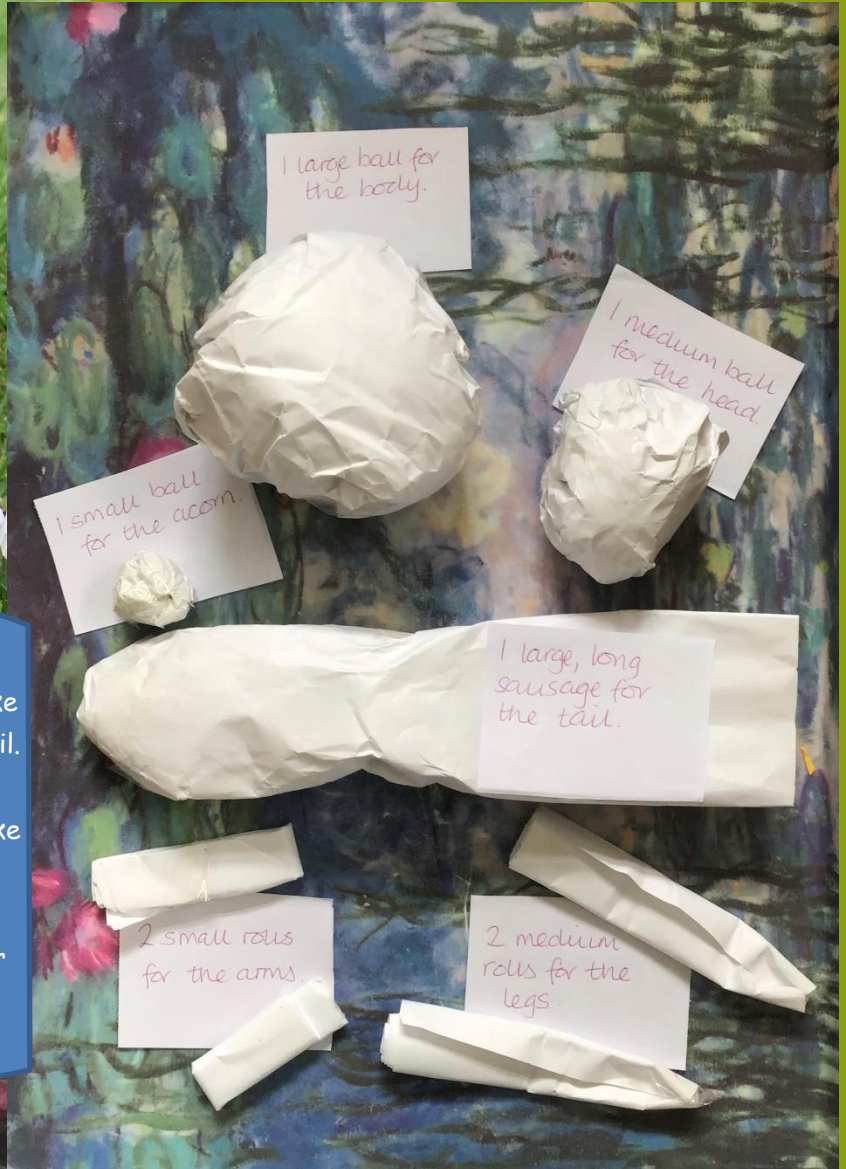


Stanley's DT. Challenge 3

Papier mache



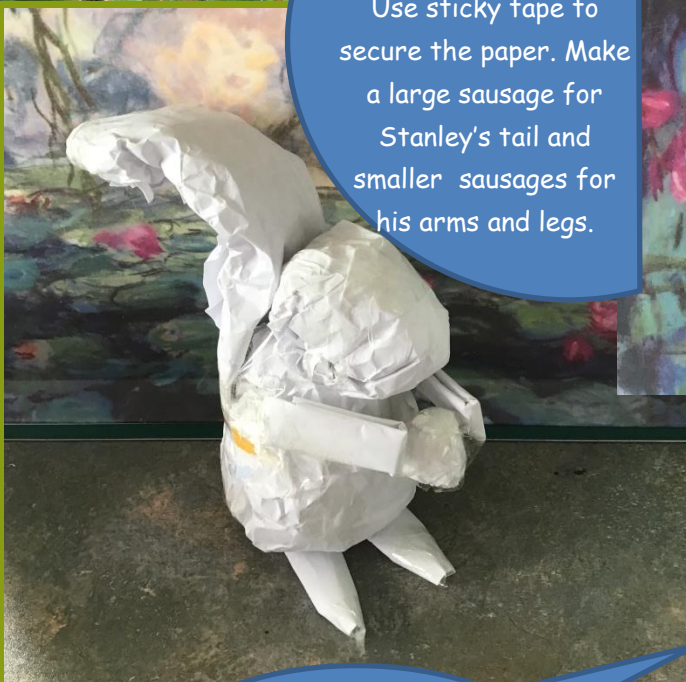
Scrunch paper to make the body, head and tail. Use sticky tape to secure the paper. Make a large sausage for Stanley's tail and smaller sausages for his arms and legs.



Join the pieces together with sticky tape and use diluted PVA glue or flour and water paste to cover with papier mache. The more layers you do, the stronger your sculpture will be. Allow each paper layer to dry fully before adding the next. Finally add a coloured layer to complete your Stanley..
