## **Covid-19 and Cyclone Amphan**

Many of you will have seen that Kolkata and the surrounding area has been badly hit by a severe cyclone. Streets are flooded and blocked by trees; buildings and community projects have been devastated; and many people now find themselves homeless and without food and water. The cyclone has come on top of the challenges that CRS and the Diocese is already facing due to the Covid-19 lockdown.

Through all this, the relief operation continues, and 4,500 families have been helped, but more is needed in this desperate situation. The first priority is to complete the second phase of deliveries of supplies to the poorest families. The homeless need shelter. There is then the work of rehabilitation. In particular children need to be brought back into CRS and Diocesan schools, as there is a danger of that the suspension of schooling, and greater impoverishment will lead to an increase in children being trafficked into child labour and child marriage. Also, women need the means of earning a livelihood so that they can help support their families.

So far, we have sent £9,000 to CRS for the Covid 19 Relief Operation, and we have a further £1,500 in donations ready to send. The crisis is by no means over yet, so please do keep fund-raising and donating.
