
# **Stanley St Andrew's Church of England School**

## Parent Questionnaire 2018/19

There were 32 returned questionnaires, relating to 36 children. The below chart shows at a glance, the year groups which responded the most.



## About the school

All of the responses from the Reception parents stated they did not know if their child enjoyed WOW week. This suggests that they do not know enough about them. All of the Reception parents stated that there was too much homework for the children. They all put they did not know if School was giving them enough information about Social Media.


When it came to homework in the rest of the year groups, other than five responses, they said that the amount of homework issued is about right.

Some comments were made about homework.

'If kids have to do a bigger research project could they have longer than a week'

'As a working parent I like to spend quality time with my daughter on an evening rather than doing homework each night. I am not against it but feel the amount is too much'

'Some weeks we have received 2 2/1 hours please remember some children have commitments outside school'




The table above shows that in the majority, parents strongly agree/ agree with the statements shown.

It seems that the majority of parents who responded know the clergy who support the school. Five stated they disagreed/didn't know. Regarding the Governors and how to contact them, 32 responses agreed they know about this. All but one response confirmed that they know about FOSS.

In terms of the school being well led and managed, 80 % strongly agreed with this statement, with the remaining 20% agreeing. Regarding school responding well to concerns, 77% strongly agree with the rest agreeing.

The below relates to the responses that feel the Breakfast Club is a valuable resource for the family.




There are some comments from those that selected 'no' that they feel it is an invaluable service to have as an option. Below are some comments relating to Breakfast Club.

Some of the responses had the below comments about After School Club.

'Lots of wide range of activities offered to engage children'

'Doesn't use very often but when he does he enjoys it. Good value for money'

'Helps being able to do some homework at the after school club'

'Sibling discount was an incentive to use the club more'

'Don't use as much due to price increase'

'My older child attends a different school and school club for £10 more a week he gets a hot meal in the evening...'

#### **Conclusions**

From the responses it seems that parents are generally very happy with the school. Parents in the Reception class may need more information when it comes to WOW weeks, and be given more input to keep their children safe on Social Media. Perhaps the clergy need promoting more within the setting, at times when Reception parents are present.

The fact that 100% stated they would recommend the school to another parent is fantastic feedback, with 83% strongly recommending the school.
