Technology - Acceptable Use Agreement for Pupils

As a church school we believe that every person, every child, and every adult is unique and special with God given gifts and talents which it our job to nurture and cherish.

We inspire all children to flourish by sharing their individual light during a life of fullness within God's love of all.

We use the school computers, iPads, and internet connection to help our learning. We know that it can be fun to use technology as part of your learning experience. We want everyone to be able to use technology, like computers and tablets, but it is important that you are safe when you are using them. We are committed to providing Internet facilities to children where an educational need is established and to promoting children's awareness of the benefits and potential dangers involved.

We have created this agreement to help you understand how to be safe when you are using technology. Please read this carefully and sign your name to show that you understand your responsibilities when using technology. Ask your teacher if there is something that you do not understand.







I will:



- Only use technology, such as a computer, when a teacher or member of staff has given me permission.
- ✓ Only use technology for the reason I have been asked to use it.
- ✓ Only use the internet when a teacher or member of staff has given me permission.
- ✓ Ask for help when I have a problem using the technology.
- Look after the device and try not to damage it.
- ✓ Tell the teacher or member of staff if my device is not working or damaged.
- ✓ Tell the teacher or member of staff if I think someone else is not using technology safely or correctly.
- ✓ Tell the teacher or member of staff if I see something online that I think is inappropriate or that makes me upset.

I will not:



- Tell another pupil my username and password.
- Share personal information, such as my age and where I live, about myself or my friends online.
- Access social media, such as Facebook and WhatsApp.
- Speak to strangers on the internet.
- * Take photos of myself or my friends using a school device.
