

How to Dress Up as Your CBBC Hero

This activity sheet will help you to dress up as your CBBC hero! This will help you work towards getting your Blue Peter Fan Club Badge.

To put together your own outfit, you may wish to do these things:

Choose Your Hero

You may already have a clear idea of which CBBC hero you'd like to dress up as or you may have several that you look up to. Do Your Research

Although you may watch your CBBC hero on the television most days, do you really remember what they wear? You may wish to do your research and watch an episode that your hero stars in to get an idea of the clothes they wear. When you have them on the screen, it's a good idea to pause the programme so that you can see their whole outfit.

Plan Your Outfit

It might be useful to draw a simple sketch of your hero outfit, trying to keep it the same as your CBBC hero's.



Putting Your Outfit Together

Think about what you have at home and what you could use to make your hero outfit. You may already have a T-shirt or jeans in the right colour or you may want to ask someone in your family if you can borrow something from their wardrobe!

Transform Your Hair

Think about how you can change your hair to make it look like your CBBC hero's. You may need to put your hair up, spike it with gel, curl it, straighten it or add plaits or bunches.



Don't Forget Your Accessories

Often, a simple outfit such as jeans and a T-shirt can look totally different with accessories. Take a close look at your CBBC hero and the accessories that they wear and try to find a match, such as:

- jewellery – like bracelets and necklaces;
- a belt;
- sunglasses or glasses.
