Each class will be issued with an individual merit book to record merits and star of the week in. Please ensure this has an owl sticker on the front and clearly labelled with the class name. Each entry should be dated so we can see that each week merits have been completed. These should be kept in your classroom.

Recording of Worship – Please take photos, any activities completed in Collective Worship or any evidence of your worships please print/ keep and place into a wallet (which will be provided) and pass onto the Yr6 Collective Worship leads for them to stick in the whole school Collective Worship evidence book. There should be at least one piece of evidence from each Collective Worship. I have decided not to continue the reflection book and so, you need to give time in your Collective Worship for reflection.

The Roots and Fruits books will be kept in the Rainbow room please return these at the end of the day so they are available for the next day for other members of staff to use.

Children need to be able to distinguish this time from lesson time and so each class will be issued with candles and a lighter (kept in your cube and locked away). Alongside this there will be a folder on the school server with images on to put up on the IWB at the start (to mark the start) Please select a new one every two weeks. As well as, this there will be a template for the different parts of a Collective Worship for you to use as a guide to plan your class worships.

Greeting at the start is each child needs to wave at one another.

Sending at the end is each child needs to whisper enjoy your afternoon or similar.
